Verdejo – Mayor de Castillo, Rueda, Spain, 2008

Sauvignon Blanc – Overstone, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2008

Bourgogne Aligote – Pierre André, Château de Corton André, **Bottle/£32.00**  
Burgundy, France, 2007

*A delicate bouquet of green apples mingling with lemon and grapefruit. A lively and full-bodied wine appreciated for its freshness when young.*

Sileni Pinot Gris – Overstone, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand, 2007 **Bottle/£33.00**

*Sileni Pinot Gris has classic peach / stonefruit characters, with concentrated fruit on the palate and a soft finish. It is a mouth-filling wine, just off-dry, and well suited to seafood, white meats and Asian food styles.*

Gavi DOC – La Slina, Piedmont, Italy, 2008 **Bottle/£34.00**

*This is a great example of this increasingly fashionable wine, full of white peach and apple flavours and underpinned with a refreshing acidity.*

Albariño – Aires de Arosa, Spain, 2007 **Bottle/£39.00**

*A medium bodied and increasingly modesih grape used to make this dry wine, with intense aromas o peaches and pears and a gently spiced palate. Refreshingly different and worth exploring!*

Pouilly Fumé – Dominique Pabiot, Loire Valley, France, 2007 **Bottle/£48.00**

*A classic Loire Sauvignon Blanc which means gooseberry, passion fruity, lime and honey aromas. The finish is refreshingly clean yet not overly acidic.*

Châteauneuf du Pape Blanc – Vieux Chemin, **Bottle /£59.00**  
Rhône Valley, France, 2005 Bottle

*Blended from Grenache Blanc, Boubelenc, Roussanne and Clairette, producing a unique slightly spicy set floral, honeyed wine with a firm acidity and fine structure.*

Meursault – 'Limozin', Domaine Bocard, Burgundy, France, 2002 **Bottle/£60.00**

*This wine is nutty, buttery and spicy with overtones of honey, cinnamon and vanilla. Deliciously dry and rich.*

Oak Aged Malbec – Finca Beltran, Argentina, 2007

Shiraz/Viognier – Woodshed, NSW, Australia, 2005

*An outstanding representation of the traditional old style of winemaking in Chile. Concentrated with a bouquet of great character and complexity the palate is well structured, with soft ripe tannins with notes of cherry and pepper and a velvety long finish*

Pinot Noir – Overstone, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand, 2008 **Bottle/£33.00**

*A wine that requires infinite patience and attention to detail to achieve the quality levels it is capable of. Overstone Pinot Noir is based on ripe cherry flavours with layers of spice and game complexity filling the palate*

Château La Tonnelle - Cru Bourgeois, Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux, France, 2006 **Bottle/£35.00**

*A combination of old vines; great vineyard location and excellent vintage have produced opulent claret that combines classic claret structure with ripe, complex fruit.*

Cote de Beaune Villages, Pierre André, Château de Corton André, Burgundy, 2006 **Bottle/£37.00**

*Good intensity of bouquet with suggestions of cherries. A gentle and smooth wine to be enjoyed when young. Fresh and spicy finish.*

Corona de Castillo Prestigio – Ribero del Duero, Spain, 2005 **Bottle/£40.00**

*A well structured wine with a rich pallet of dense bramble fruits; with a velvety texture. Barrel aged for 16 months in French, American & Caucasus oak; and a further 12 months in bottle. Long lasting with an exquisitely elegant finish*

Savigny Les Beaune 'Futey' – Pierre Janny, Burgundy, France, 1995 **Bottle/£46.00**

*A wine made from 100% Pinot Noir, showing classic aromas of cherry, kirsch and vanilla. On the palate is revealed a rich, dark sexy Savigny with generous rich fruit flavours.*

Rioja Gran Reserva – Jaun de Alzate, Spain, 2001 **Bottle/£50.00**

*Powerfully full-bodied, this robust Rioja is deeply aromatic, balanced and elegant with an intense red brick colour. It has spent 4 years in oak casks and a further 3 maturing in bottle before its release. A top-class Gran Reserva Rioja.*

Amarone della Valpolicella Classico – Fratelli Farina, Italy, 2005 **Bottle/£59.00**
